Ground Service Equipment (GSE) Mechanic

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIP

The Ground Service Equipment Mechanic reports directly to the Director of Maintenance.

Supervises: The trainees and or assistants assigned to him/her

BASIC FUNCTION

The Ground Service Equipment Mechanic is responsible for ensuring all ground support equipment are in proper working condition, and in accordance with approved procedures and data. The Ground Service Equipment Mechanic liaises with the operations personnel to ensure proper dispatch of ground equipment is maintained. He takes into consideration work orders and coordinates the planning of maintenance during the shift and in general. He/She reports to the Director of Maintenance any shortcomings in usage, equipment, policies, and parts. The Ground Service Equipment Mechanic shall also assist the Aircraft mechanics in their daily duties whenever required.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have an education in automotive equipment.
- Minimum five (5) years relevant work experience.
- Has knowledge of Diesel engines and generators.
- Demonstrates the supervisory ability and technical knowledge required to perform the duties of this position.
- Good physical condition (function requires some lifting and carrying of all types of items)
- Knowledge of implementing scheduled maintenance procedures and software.
- Knowledge of the Maintenance Schedules, Work Order procedures, and proper method and application of the different forms required to complete the work.
- Good command of the English language, oral as well as written
- He/she has basic skills in computer databases and Microsoft Office.
- Must be team-oriented and possess a pleasant attitude.
- Must be accurate and hardworking, and can work independently.

REQUIREMENTS

- Possesses a certificate of good conduct not older than three months.
- Pass a pre-employment medical done by the company doctor.
- Performs other duties as may be assigned by the Department Head.
